


We offer something for guests in search of a less rigid and traditional view of luxury, something more human and mindful of its impact on the environment and the people who live there.




A Summer in the Mediterranean and Beyond...


A Winter in the Caribbean





The Club Med 2 first set sail in 1992 from Le Havre in France on a maiden voyage to New Caledonia. For six months in the autumn and winter, it cruised from the des Pins, Hienghéne, the extraordinary Plage d'Ouvéa, and Port Villa on the Efate Island. Once a month, it even sails on a voyage of discovery to the islands north of Vanuatu, where the much of the sea still remains uncharted.

An invitation to explore, Club Med 2 more than earns its moniker of "legendary French sailing yacht". A quick look at the facts and figures that make it unique in the world.

Half the size of a large cruise ship, which grants us the privilege of accessing ports that are typically off-limits to tourist ships.

This is the height of the part of the ship that is submerged in the water. This allows Club Med 2 to closely skirt the coastlines where the water is more shallow. For you, this means incredible views and the opportunity to discover uncharted territory.

Using sails in addition to the ship's engines allows Club Med 2 to conserve up to 20% of its fuel. When the sails reach retirement age, we recycle them into unique accessories that can be purchased at our onboard boutique.




Accessing the Inaccessible






Exploring the *renovation*

The Suites

"Contemporary touches enhance the new suites while preserving their historic charm. They feature dark wooden furniture, thick carpeting, and portholes. Some lines from Arthur Rimbaud's poem "Le Bateau Ivre" are woven into a linen bed runner. The color scheme has been updated, and the sofa and armchair have an outdoors-inspired design. The headboard, unfolded like a nautical chart, displays a portrait of a young captain against the backdrop of the Pacific seas and Mata Utu (where the ship is registered)."



Portofino

"Originally inspired by Herman Melville's novel "Moby Dick", the iconic Portofino bar now takes on a more high-tech look. The bar, once sheltered under a wooden sperm whale tail in homage to marine carpentry, has been replaced by the sleek, metallic skin of a stealthy fish. The furniture has also been updated, featuring white leather and linen, emphasizing comfort and lightness. Behind the festive area, you'll find a cozy lounge where you can retreat, nestled away next to a large bookshelf."


10 PM
