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

For beginners:

Curious about diving? Begin by practicing in low-depth, secure areas, shallow enough to stand comfortably.

Equipment rental is included: diving regulator, diving tank, weight belt and weights, mask, fins, snorkel, buoyancy control device and wetsuit.

Q1. When is the peak season for spotting manta rays?

The best chance to encounter mantas is from September to November, though they can be spotted near Club Med year-round.

Q2. How many dives can you do in a day?

Experienced divers can dive up to three times a day (two dives in the morning and one in the afternoon).
